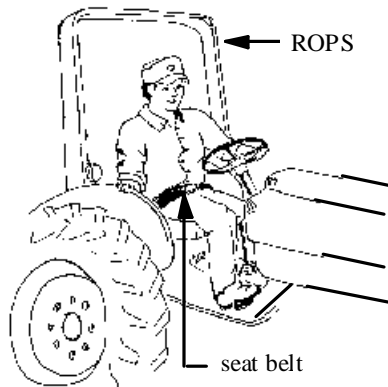
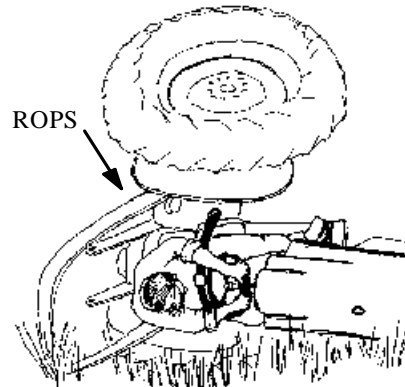


Public Service Announcements (About Farm Tractor Overturns and Their Prevention)

ROPS, Seatbelts, and the “Frame of Safety”

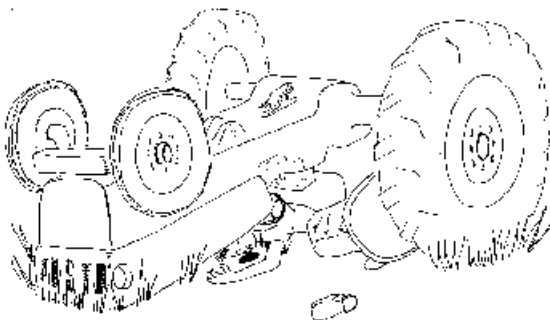


A fastened seat belt holds the driver on the seat

The tractor overturned in less than a second and he was crushed under its weight. In a recent six-year period, 76 Kentucky farmers died in tractor overturns. ROPS and seat belts could have saved all 76 lives.

He knew overturns could be deadly. He believed by being careful he could avoid an overturn. He thought he didn't need a ROPS on his tractor. What do you think?

These public service announcements present facts and stories about tractor overturns and injuries and how ROPS and seat belts save farmers lives and money. The messages are intended for mass communication of this information to members of farm communities.
